### PRESENTATION:

The purpose of the Highway 2 Highway (H2H) project is to improve mobility for multiple modes of travel in the arterial connection between the Seward and Glenn Highways within the Municipality of Anchorage. The completion of the project will reduce congestion; improve travel efficiency, neighborhood connectivity and safety.

The cost for the project (2005 AMATS LRTP) is expected to be at around \$600M and an estimated savings of about \$45 M from reduced delays and \$23M from reduced crashes annually. The project is currently in the Alternatives Development phase with construction scheduled to begin between 2013 and 2015.
