Bogard Road Extension East: Mike Campfield, P.E. Project Manager, DOWL-HKM.

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) is initiating the Bogard Road Extension East project to extend Bogard Road from near Trunk Road to the Glenn Highway. Expected features include a two-lane paved highway with minimum 12-foot travel lanes, 8-foot paved shoulders, right-of-way acquisition for a 4-lane facility, turning lanes, pedestrian facilities, a separated pathway, lighting, intersection improvements, and drainage structures. The purpose of this project is to provide an additional east-west corridor to facilitate east-west travel across the core area of the MSB.
